

VOLUNTEER BUILD SITE PHOTOGRAPHER

Supervisor: Community Resources Manager

Objective: Strengthen Honolulu Habitat's library of visual media; capture high resolution, person-forward images of construction volunteers and homeowners on the build site.

Responsibilities:

- Take candid pictures of volunteers and homeowners working on the build site
- Edit and/or retouch photographs
- Provide final images to Habitat within <u>72 hours</u> of shift
- Grant permission to Habitat to use, publish and replicate images on website, social media, print publications and news release

Schedule: Friday and/or Saturday; 9:30 – 11:30am (preferred)

Time commitment: two (2) shifts per month (total 4-6 hours per month)

Training and support:

- Habitat will provide photography brand guidelines and orientation
- · Volunteers will receive feedback and support from Habitat staff
- Safety: PPE and build site safety training provided
- File transfer: Habitat will provide access to a shared folder for image transfer

Qualifications:

- Minimum age: 16 years
- Photography and editing experience
- Reliable transportation
- Volunteers must provide their own equipment and editing software
