Description

The Wahine Build committee oversees the planning, promotion and execution of Wahine Build. Members are organized by sub-committee to actively support outreach, recruitment, marketing, fundraising and logistical planning. The fundraising goal of this committee is \$100,000 in FY23.

Qualifications

Women from all walks of life are welcome to join the Wahine Build committee. Ideal members possess a strong interest in empowering women, support the mission of Honolulu Habitat and are active in their community.

Expected commitment

- Attend monthly committee meetings for 12 months
- Complete action items between meetings (approx. 1-2 hours per week)
- Serve as an ambassador for Wahine Build and Habitat
- Leverage personal and professional networks to garner support
- Commit to raising \$1,000 for Wahine Build through sponsor procurement, peer-to-peer fundraising, gifts in-kind and/or personal donation
- Attend one (1) Wahine Build event or build day (minimum)
