WHO IS THIS FOR:

- Ideal for current homeowners who are residing in the home
- Improve safety, value, and appearance of their home
- Allows kupuna to age in place with increased mobility

SCOPE OF WORK:

- Installation of ramps and rails
- Termite treatment
- Appliance replacement
- Window replacement
- Gutter replacement
- Solar water heater replacement
- Fence repair
- Stair repair
- Minor plumbing work
- Minor electrical work

HOW IT WORKS:

- Submit application & financial documents
- HHH conducts financial assessment
- Habitat Construction Crew home visit to assess repairs needed
- Project plan created
- \$10,000 maximum for project costs
- Repairs performed through Habitat's Construction Crew and community volunteers
- 1-7 year, 0% interest loan through Honolulu Habitat for Humanity
