Honolulu Habitat for Humanity Home Build Program Qualifications

- Currently own land without a mortgage **or** be named as the lessee on a long-term leasehold (through Department of Hawaiian Home Lands, or other). Property must not have any liens or delinquent real estate property tax
- Currently living in substandard, unsafe, rent-burdened or overcrowded housing
- Meet income requirements for Honolulu County set by Housing and Urban Development (HUD) (*see chart below*)
- Any prior bankruptcies must be fully discharged for a minimum of 2 years
- Demonstrate a good credit history
- Pass a background check
- Willing to partner with Honolulu Habitat and contribute 275 hours of sweat equity (per adult) building your home and the homes of other Habitat homeowners
- Must be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident currently residing in Hawaii
