POSITION SUMMARY:

The **ReStore Associate** reports to the ReStore Manager and is responsible for assisting ReStore Manager and Donation Coordinator with all aspects of ReStore operations. Must have an understanding and appreciation for the mission of Honolulu Habitat for Humanity. Ability to work independently and in a fast paced ever changing environment. Must have strong problem solving and customer relation skills. Shows attention to detail with or without supervision, strong integrity and remains consistent dealing with all kinds of individuals and customers. This is a full time or part time, non-exempt position.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES: Duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Ensure cleanliness and safety of the warehouse and maintain the sales floor.
- Provide excellent customer service to every ReStore customer.
- Serve as back up driver if needed.
- Assist with donation screening and pickups, including off site pickups.
- Loading and unloading box truck before, during and after pickups.
- Help supervise volunteers and give guidance.
- Operate cash register and POS system accurately.
- Other duties as assigned by ReStore Manager.

Other Duties, as Assigned

- Performs other appropriate duties and activities as assigned.
