Responsibilities:

- Serve as the last point of contact for our customers (make them smile).
- Register sales by scanning or manually entering purchases.
- Collect payment and make accurate change.
- Maintain a clean and organized cash wrap area.
- Occasionally price and stock items if/when time permit.

- Ability to operate POS (point of sale) system and handle cash responsibly.
- Strong basic math skills. No calculus needed but you should be able to add and subtract quickly and accurately.
- Personality! You are a people person and enjoy helping customers.
- A willingness to learn quickly. You can follow instruction and feel comfortable asking questions.
